TRUenergy Gas Assets is committed to conducting its business without causing harm to people or the environment.

TRUenergy recognises that the responsibility for health, safety and the environment lies with every manager, employee and contractor, and forms an integral part of what we do, at all levels of the organisation.

We will comply with CLP and TRUenergy health, safety and environmental policies and objectives throughout the operational life of the Iona Gas Plant and other Gas Assets operations and facilities, without compromise and as an integral part of our management philosophy, by a range of measures, including those set out below.

- Implement and maintain an Integrated Management System that incorporates health, safety and environmental plans and procedures to provide a safe place of work and minimize impact on the environment.
- Involve all TRUenergy Gas Assets people and contractors in the effective implementation of health, safety, and environmental management.
- Ensure a systematic approach to proactively identify hazards and manage the risks to as low as reasonably practicable.
- Provide our people with and ensure our contractors have the training and resources necessary to meet our commitments and continuously enhance knowledge, awareness, behaviours and competency in safety, health and environmental management.
- Sharing and exchanging knowledge, and experience with suppliers, contractors, business partners and the local community, with the aim of mutually enhancing the health, safety and environment performance.
- Actively pursue continuous improvements on safety and environment performance through targeting defined safety and environment initiatives and establishing challenging measurable objectives and targets and regularly reviewing performance.
- Comply with and where appropriate, exceed all health, safety and environmental laws and any other health, safety and environmental requirements to which TRUenergy Gas Assets has made a specific commitment for the Iona Gas Plant and other operations or facilities.
- Continue to focus on managing the risks associated with noise emissions, dangerous goods, safety behaviors, contractors and project construction and integration.

We will select partners and contractors based on their clear acceptance and commitment to standards similar to TRUenergy's and CLP's and after the contract is established, we will enforce contract agreement to ensure Contractors meet their commitment to safety and environment.

We will ensure all project plans support and reflect a commitment to achievement of CLP's policy and principles.
